



What are the requirements to become an Ambassador4EUFuture?

Our main target is people who have an international mindset. We will particularly focus on the Erasmus Generation (current and former exchange students and Alumni), as they are the most pro-European and tend to have a higher interest in EU related issues.

Personal desired competencies (5 points total)

- Being over 18 years of age (if you are between 14 and 18 years of age, we would need you to count with the support of an accompanying adult -parent, school teacher-);
- Have an international mindset;
- Adaptability to sudden work changes and ability to work to deadlines;
- Problem solving and goal oriented;
- Respectful for diversity and collaborative;
- High sense of responsibility, initiative and reliability;
- and self-motivated to contribute to the shaping of Europe's future)

Professional / Academic desired skills: 5 points total

- Demonstrated ability to work in a multinational team.
- Being able to communicate in English (B2 level) and the local language of the country you are based in.
- Having an International mindset
- Having proven experience in EU exchange programmes (such as an Erasmus+ traineeship or university exchange, an Erasmus+ project at school or an experience abroad with the European Voluntary Service) is highly desirable
- Proven analytical and report writing skills will be considered an asset
- Having strong organisational skills
- Experience in planning and organizing events is highly valued.
- Being able to motivate and mobilize the groups of people
- Strong interest in European Affairs issues and youth field.

Having taken part in the 9 May event, your participation will be taken into account, so you'll be given 2 points for your application as an Ambassador4EUfuture.
